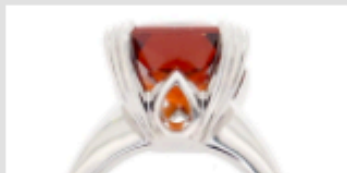
An incredible 50 carat Aquamarine
